This year has been very rewarding for our Society. We have built a web site, elected officers, voted on and accepted By-laws and had our first official Nuckolls Reunion.

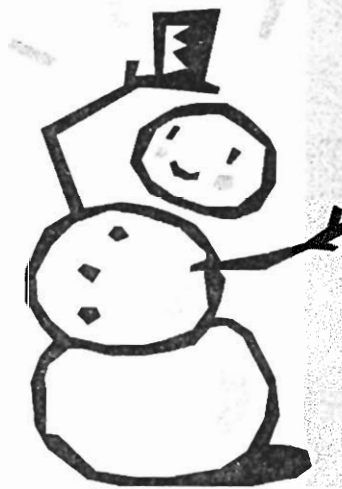
In 1999 we will move ahead on the project every one is waiting for, the 2nd Edition of the book, "First Virginia Nuckolls and Kindred."

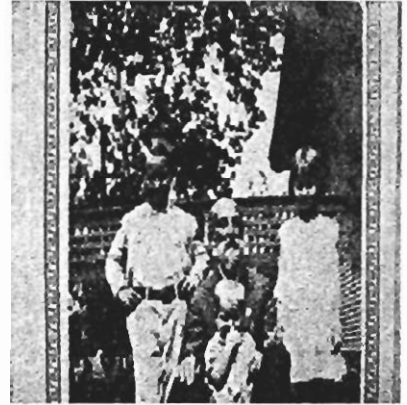

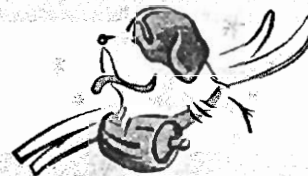

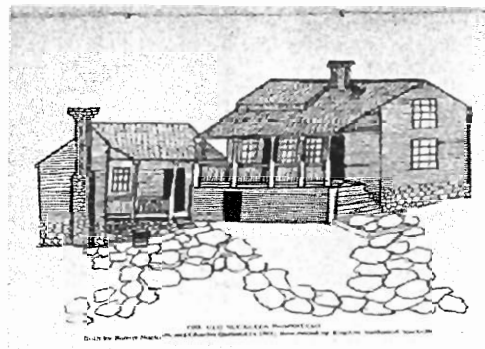

Civil War Letter from Samuel R. Nuckolls August 27, 1864

Mt. Jackson, VA
August 27th, 1864

Mr. I. R. Swift,

Dear Brother, you doubtless have heard
this of my being wounded and there is
no chance of getting away only on wagon
to Staunton, and I will start for Staunton
in a few days, or as soon as I can travel.

You will do me a favor if
my wife has not heard of
my being wounded to send
her word as soon as you
receive this. And if any
one comes for me, they
will come direct to Staun-
ton as they are giving furlough from that
place. I stand a very good chance to get
one. I received my wound the 20th day



of this month and I am glad
to say it is doing well. I re-
ceived a gun-shot in my right
(sic) should (sic) and arm all
with the same ball. The ball
is in my arm as yet - in the
elbow. But don't suffer any
uneasiness bout me, as I am doing
finely, and hope to be home soon.
And truly I remain your s until death.

I did not get anything from the Abstracts of Law Order Books or Land Patent Books. Like most places in this area, their records were burned during the war. I have not been able to find birth date of Clarence Pendleton NUCKOLS abt 1860. In the 4th Virginia Cavalry list of Nuckolls, his father was listed as KIA. 9 May 1864.

Bk G p165 Indenture 12 Mar 1792 James Nuckols to Thomas Barret for 100pds a parcel of land of 20ac on the north side of the Little River. John Poindexter, clerk.

Bk2 p29 5 Jan 1767 Will of Charles Nuckolls Wife Keziah is given all the estate until her death then to be divided equally among the children. Children mentioned, sons, James, William, Richard and Lewis. Executors, Naddy Thompson, Samuel Nuckolls and John Bullock. Witnesses, William Shelton, Isham Watkins, John Bullock

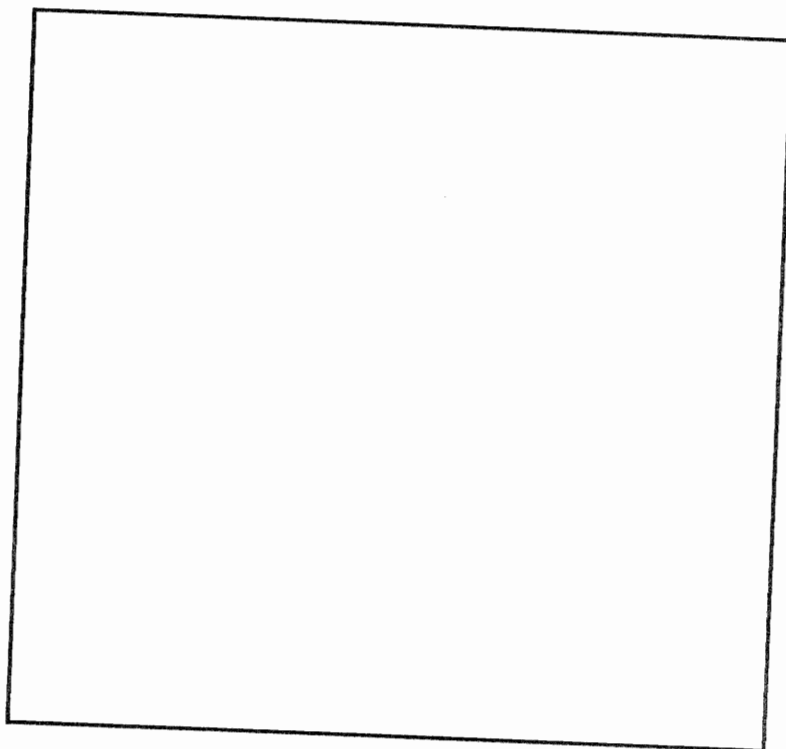
