### ACCIDENT RESULTS IN SHOOTING DEATH

Lone Oak– Camp George Mahand, 47, was shot to death early Saturday morning behind the Lone Oak Post Office. Two witnesses, Shirley Slemmons, manager of a funeral home, and J L Hodge said they were standing in front of the funeral home across the street from the post office when they saw Mahand, a rural mail carrier pull up to the post office in his pick-up around 7:30. Shortly after, they heard a shot and looked back again to see Mahand falling backwards from the left side of the pickup. Sheriff R W (Red) Wood said that a 12 gauge shotgun standing behind the seat of the truck, apparently fell over and went off as Mahand was reaching for something. Mahand was dead on arrival at Greenville Surgical Hospital. According to the doctor, he was shot in the left chest and through the heart. Justice of the Peace Homer Wacasey ruled accidental death. Funeral services were at 2:30 Sunday in the Lone Oak Methodist Church, with Rev Charles Hart officiating and Mr Frances Bell assisting. Born Nov 20, 1922 in Cumby, he was the son of Camp D and Virginia

McReynolds Mahand. He was a Navy Veteran of World War II and had served as a rural mail carrier for the last twenty years. He was a member of the Prairie Valley Baptist Church. He married the former Mary Rhodes April 11, 1948, in Greenville. Survivors included the widow, one son Mark, and three daughters, Melinda, Julia and Jennie, all of the home; his parents, Mr and Mrs Camp Douglass Mahand of Lone Oak; three sisters, Mrs W H Spinks of Mission, **Mrs H NUCKLES OF HOUSTON** and Mrs Richard Roland of Dallas; and several nieces and nephews.

Sudden death on the eve of the 17th inst, **Ann Virginia NUCKOLS** in the 31st year of her age, formerly of Richmond.

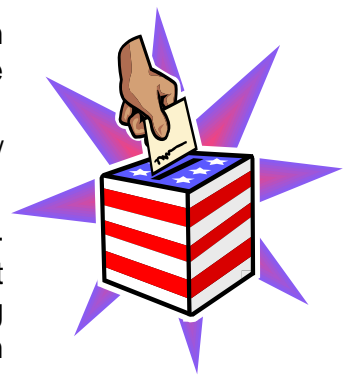
### Washington Post July 13, 1904

#### Crash Kills 1 Injures 1

A grand Prairie man was killed and a Dallas truck driver seriously injured early Wednesday in a fiery 2-truck crash on Interstate Highway 35 about 2 miles west of Norman Okla. Clyde LaCrone, 28 of 922 SE 11th in Grand Prairie, died shortly after the semi-trailer truck in which he was riding hit a parked gravel dump truck, the AP reported. LaCrone was trapped in the sleeping compartment and suffered third degree burns over his entire body when the wreckage burst into flames. The driver, **Leroy Nuckolls**, 30, of 2311 Pentagon Parkway in Dallas was reported in serious condition at a Norman hospital later. The driver of the parked dump truck escaped injury.
