New Discoveries in Family of Samuel Nuckols and Aley Cole

Society member Chuck Nuckols in Ft Collins, Colorado recently ordered mini-books for himself and all of his children.

In preparing these great gifts for folks, it gives me time to concentrate on each family line and to attempt to resolve some issues as well as continue some research. This led me to some new discoveries with the help of a researcher in Louisville combined with the updated Kentucky death certificates on ancestry.com.

Thanks also to the help of Janie Campbell to piece this family together as accurately as possible and for submitting photos which were uploaded to our Scrapbook.

The death certificate for Samuel Nuckols was located and his mother was named as Nancy Burnett. His sister Cordelia was the informant. We are suggesting that since Sams mother died before 1850, neither of his children really knew his mother. Since Nancy Barneet was a grandmother it is highly probable they remember him speaking of her and this is how the name came to be on

the death certificate.

A marriage record was found in Louisville courthouse for Pouncey to Ann Jane Creighton Dec 18, 1844. This suggests this is the mother of Samuel since he was born Mar 8 1846, the average time for births.

Janie called my attention to the 1850 census neighbors of Pouncey which really told the story. Olivia lived on the next farm the widow of Nimrod Jarrett whom she had married Aug 22, 1843. It would seem she probably took care of Pouncey's two young children. We discovered Sam had a sister who was burned in a fire in 1854. She appears in the 1850 census age 10 months. Her name was Eleanor. The neighbor on the other side had a wife named Cordelia who probably also helped widower Pouncey, which is why Pouncey and Olivia named their child Cordelia. Pouncey married Olivia Ann Ferry Jarrett Nov 26, 1857 in Louisville.

Janie Campbell has a living relative who distinctly remembers her ancestor saying Sam's mother was Angeline Cooper. But the evidence, so far, does not support this. Also unable to find and Angeline Cooper in the area in 1850. Samuel Nuckols death occurred May 8 1919 in Clay Co, KY

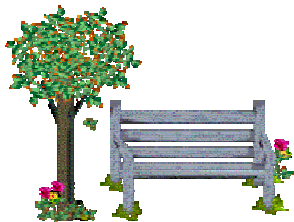
