Nuckolls Cemetery Restoration

Forsyth County, Georgia

June 23, 2001

The descendants of Nancy Anne Burruss Nuckolls gathered at the site of the family cemetery located on the old Nuckolls' home-place (now the home of Mr. and Mrs. Tommy Bagwell) to celebrate the restoration of the Cemetery. This Nuckolls Family Cemetery was established in the 1840's and measures approximately 68 feet by 48 feet. The cemetery fell into disrepair after the Nuckolls family moved from the property in 1938 and we, the descendants, did not want to see the cemetery completely abandoned. The Bagwell Family cooperated fully during the restoration process.

The program for the rededication ceremony began with a welcome by Benny Lamar Nuckolls; continued with a family history of those buried at the site by Carolyn Nuckolls Baker; "God's Acre" recited by Richard Burruss Nuckolls; family memories by James Nathaniel Nuckolls; the legend of the Nuckolls White Rose by John Alexander Nuckolls; placing of symbolic white roses by June Nuckols Strickland; and concluded with prayer by Benny L. Nuckolls.

Those buried at this site are:

Nancy Anne Burruss

Great-grandmother Anne was the daughter of John Burruss and Mary Harris. She married James Alexander Nuckolls in Louisa County, Virginia on November 20, 1817. Her father was deceased at the time of the marriage and her brothers John Burruss and Henry Burruss provided the security bond and served as witnesses. William Cooke performed the marriage ceremony. Anne and Alexander had 9 children, many of

whom were born in Hall County, GA. Anne and Alexander moved to the Roberts Military District of Hall County prior to 1830. The 1830 census of Hall County states they were responsible for 23 family members that included 15 slaves. They were still living in Hall County when the 1840 census was taken. They had an estate of approximately 1000 acres adjoining the Chattahoochee River in Hall County. Anne and Alexander began purchasing land in Forsyth County, GA in 1834 and sometime after 1840 they moved to this location where Alexander amassed an estate of 1300 acres by 1850 and 1400 acres by 1860.

Anne and Alexander joined Beaver Run Baptist Church April 13th, 1842. The church records indicate that her name was Nancy and that she died in 1848. Church records also indicate that Anne and Alexander were very active in this church. After Anne's death, Alexander became a member of Antioch Baptist Church, and later Bethel Baptist Church. During the late 1860's, Alexander and several of his children moved to Whitfield County, GA and two of his sons, Joel Thomas, Sr., and Alexander Burruss remained in Forsyth County, GA. Alexander died in 1875 and is buried on the property that he owned in Whitfield County, GA.

Nuckolls' children

Alexander Burruss Nuckolls, the son of Anne and Alexander, and his wife, Terrissa Smith, purchased a large portion of Alexander's estate in 1862 and they lived here for most of their lives. They buried three young sons in this cemetery. Frederick Gustave at 3 years, Robert William at 2 months, and Smith who died at birth.

Emma Light

Emma joined Bethel Baptist Church in September of 1882. Emma married James Alexander Nuckolls, the grandson of Anne and Alexander, December 26, 1883 in Forsyth County, GA. Emma and James had one son, Major Alexander Nuckolls, Sr. Major was born June 5, 1885. Emma apparently died between 1885 and 1889. We are unsure of her burial site, however, we chose to remember her by placing a marker here.

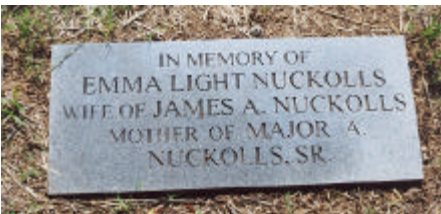

Nuckolls' slaves

There are slaves buried at this location. In the 1860 Slave Schedule taken by Talbot Strickland, there were 8 slaves dwellings located on this property, and at least 27 slaves were living here at that time. Mariah, Mary, Marie, Venaia, Caty, and Spence were members of Beaver Ruin Baptist Church during the time Anne and Alexander were members. Anna and Mary were also members of Antioch Baptist Church. We do not know which slaves are buried here, but find it important to place a marker honoring them and the other unknown slaves.

After the ceremony, 70 descendants gathered for a reunion meal at Shady Grove Baptist Church. Good food and fellowship were enjoyed by all.

Note: All churches mentioned in this article are located within three miles of the Old Nuckolls' home-place.



MEN IN THE MILITARY

William Preston Nuckolls was born in Atlantic City, New Jersey, April 13, 1905. He attended Swarthmore College and the University of Virginia Law School.

He entered the Air Corps as a flying cadet in June 1931. A year later he was graduated from flying school and was assigned to France Field, Panama Canal Zone, where he served as a pilot of a bombardment squadron. He is a Command Pilot He was assigned to Randolph Field, Texas, in 1938 as Flight Instructor and later was instrumental in a public relations program for aviation cadet procurement. In 1942 He was transferred to Washington, D. C., as Deputy Director of the War Department Bureau of Public Relations for Air.

General Nuckolls was transferred to the European Theatre of Operations in 1943, as a member of the Plans Division of the Allied Expeditionary Air Force under Lieutenant General Hoyt S. Vandenberg. AEF coordinated the Air effort in connection with the Normandy invasion. General Nuckolls returned to the U. S. in August, 1945, and in September, 1947, he was appointed Director of the Air Informational Division, Office of the Secretary of the Air Force at Washington, D. C. In August, 1949, he entered the Air War College at Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama, and was graduated in July, 1950. General Nuckolls was then assigned to the Far East Air Forces, Tokyo, Japan. As the Military Armistice Conference began in July 1951, in Kaesong, Korea, General Nuckolls was appointed by General Matthew B. Ridgway as Official Spokesman, United Nations Command (Advance) in Korea He continued to serve in this capacity until designated by General Ridgway to attend the Japanese Peace Treaty Signing Conference in San Francisco as a Special Advisor to the U. S. Delegation. With the Korean Armistice negotiations stalemated, General Nuckolls left the Far East in February, 1953, and rejoined General Ridgway at

Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe (SHAPE). He assumed his present Command of the 33rd Air Division (Defense) On 28 July 1954.

General Nuckols has been awarded the Legion of Merit with two Oak Leaf Clusters, Bronze Star Medal with one Cluster, the French Crois de Guerre with palm, and the Belgian Croix de Guerre, the latter two for his services during World War 11.

He was married in 1933 to Miss Alice Browne, of Karnes City, Texas. He was promoted to First Lieutenant on 20 March 1939; to Captain on 1 February 1941; to Major on 1 February 1942; to Lieutenant Colonel on 20 July 1942; to Colonel on 12 December 1942; to Brigadier General on 4 October 1950.

(The ancestry of General William Preston Nuckols is unknown) According to the SSDI, William died May of 1981 in Florida. I will send for his SS info which will give his parents names.

 Obituary: ELKTON, Ky. -- Noel Thomas Nuckols, former mayor of Elkton, died Sunday in the emergency room of Jennie Stuart Medical Center in Hopkinsville after suffering a ruptured aneurysm. He was 81. Nuckols, a native of Todd County, was mayor from 1966 through 1969. He had owned Nuckols Seed Co. from 1949-1980. He was past president of Elkton Rotary Club and Kentucky Seedman Association. He was a member of Elkton Baptist Church and a former member of Elkton Masonic Lodge. Survivors include his wife, the former Mae Evans; two sons, William E. Nuckols of Chattanooga, Tenn., and Noel Thomas Nuckols Jr. of Tampa, Fla.; and three grandchildren. The funeral will be at 11 a.m. tomorrow at Latham Funeral Home, with burial in Glenwood Cemetery. Visitation will be at the funeral home from 5 to 8 p.m. today.

Obits, cont.

Being a Master Mason of the Cambria Lodge, the funeral services were in charge of the Masons; burial in Cayucos Cemetery, Calif. Nathaniel Nuckolls moved to Mo. 1845, from VA., taught school; m. 1845, Cass Co., Mo., to Sarah Fine, b. Jan. 16, 1828, d. 1889, buried in Paso Robles Cemetery, California. Nathaniel's first trip to California was made in 1849 by sea around Cape Horn, South America, during the Gold Rush days in Calif.; he mined gold in Placer, Butte, Lassen, and other Counties along the Sierra Nevada Mountains. Returned to Mo. 1851 via Isthmus of Panama, Gulf of Mexico, and the Mississippi River. He left Independence, Mo., Apr. 1852, with his family of wife and 2 sons, in ox-drawn covered wagons across the plains to Calif. Following the trail along the North Platte River to Wyoming, crossing the state to Independence Rock, located in the southwest corner of Wyoming. where the long wagon train spent 2 days repairing wagons and resting the stock. There on July 4, 1852, little Margaret Nuckolls was born. Crossing Nevada via Humbolt Sink, Nev., then on through the Truckee Pass (south of Reno, Nev.) to California, their long 6 months journey was ended Oct. 1852 in Sonoma Co., Calif., which borders on the Pacific Ocean, at the ranch of John Swift (a relative). Nathaniel Nuckolls was the first County Assessor of Sonoma Co., and held this office for a number of years. Of the 16 children: Holt, Mary Virginia, Frederick and William were born in Sonoma Co.; their next move was to Marin Co. Ranch: where George, Jeffie, Thomas, Maria, Sena and Flora were born. A 600 acre ranch in San Luis Obispo County. on Old Creek was the next move of this large family, a distance Of 300 miles, taking 4 weeks' time with many large wagons of belongings, horses, and cows, crossing the San Francisco Bay on flatboats, arriving Oct. 1869. So life began again on Old Creek, where a large house, big brick dairy barn, huge horse barn were soon built; they were kept busy making cheese and butter, and a lot of farming. The last 3 of the 16 children were born here, Creed, Hugh and Jake. Finding the burden too great to operate the ranch, it was sold; Nathaniel and his remaining family moved to Paso Robles in San Luis Obispo Co., Calif., Aug. 1, 1889. 'The doors of the Great Beyond were opened ' and on August 13, 1889, a very great man and father passed through.
