MARRIAGES

UNKNOWN

Hattie Miller **NUCKOLS** md Edgar **WILTSHIRE** 10/23/1896 Goochland Co, VA. What makes this one interesting is the search in Goochland County 1900 Census which leaves another mystery. In Dover Twp pg 169 resides Abner Clopton **NUCKOLS** and (according to the Kinship report) unrelated family of John Franklin **NUCKOLS** (Benjamin, William Knight, Wm The Patriot). John Franklin died in 1900 before the census was enumerated and his wife Jane b 2/1833, widow, 9 children, 5 living. She is living with her son Weldon b 4/1877, daughter Nancy C **WILTSHIRE** b 6/1860, Married, 1 child 1 living and granddaughter Bessie born 6/1894. Her son Horace B **NUCKOLS** lives next door. The 1880 census accounts for 6 of her nine children. As is customary for brothers and sisters to marry, I would think a sister of Nancy born aft 1880 may have married this unknown **WILTSHIRE** brother. Edgar **WILTSHIRE** is found in Dover on pg 168 b 4/1874, wife Hattie born 3/1874 married 4 years, 1 child Geneva C b 11/1899. *Hattie did not appear in the 1880 Census as a child.* Then the second mystery is on the other side of the household is a William C **NUCKOLS** b 6/1871 a widow age 28. This man did not appear in the 1880 Census with John Franklin and Jane **NUCKOLS** as a son. With him is living an aunt named Susan E **SHEPHERD** b 12/1831, single age 68. I am going to attach these two as children of John Franklin and Jane **NUCKOLS** and include this article with the notes. The 1880 census dates for births of their children are spaced appropriately for these two siblings, and the notation of Jane having 6 children living is more good evidence.

J L **NUCKOLS** md J H **ANDERSON** May 27, 1885 in Volusia, Florida. Not knowing the gender of these two, I checked the 1900 Census for Nuckols

and only find Hezekiah **NUCKOLS** b 2/1837 md 31years age 63 KY VA KY. Wife Adelia C b 8/1844 age 55, no children born, KY KY KY. (Hezekiah, Andrew, Pouncey). Unfortunately I cant search Anderson as there are hundreds and you cant search just one county.

James **NUCKOLS** md Elizabeth Ann **CRUMP** Jan 27, 1812 in Henrico Co, VA. He must have died prior to 1850, as Henrico County has no James **NUCKOLS** in the census. However, I do find an unidentified William H **NUCKOLS** age 37 (born c1813), wife Ann 38, Mary E 12, James H 10, William P 8, Maria 5, Virginia 2, Elizabeth 40, Sarah Ann, 28. Did this William name a son James after his father James?. Very probable. The 1840 Census of Virginia must not be complete on line, as they show no Nuckols (this is laughable!) In Louisa Co 1830 is James D Nuckols 0002001-0002000. 1840 shows James D Nicholls in Louisa Co, which may be him. The William in the 1850 census fits in this household.

John Smith **PURYEAR** md c1860 Kate **NUCKOLS** Henrico Co, VA. A search of the 1880 Virginia Census for **PURYEAR** shows no John with a wife Kate or Catherine. The only **PURYEAR** familes in Henrico County in 1880 were black and mulatto.

William **PURYEAR** md a Miss **NUCKOLS** in Richmond, c 1850. The 1880 Census (as in previous marriage couple) shows no William **PURYEAR** the right age and location. A check was also made of the 1850 Census with no luck.

Edward **SACRA** md Annie E **NUCKOLLS** Dec 10, 1855 in Louisa Co, VA. There were **SACRAE** in 1850 Hanover County. *Edmund* appeared in 1850, 1860 and 1870. 1870 Edmund appears in Hewlitt Twp pg 105. Conveniently page 105b at ancestry is "damaged". In 1860 he lived in

Negrofoot Twp pg 480. He was age 50 with no wife, daughter age 14 named Eliza E and Mary 6.

Deemath **NUCKALS** md Elzie A **SHINN** Aug 17, 1884 in Vernon Co, MO. 1900 Census shows only two families in Vernon County, MO. One was William **NUCKOLS** age 23 boarding with **HORNBECK** family and the other is an unknown connection, John Lewis **NUCKOLS** b 1842 MO VA VA a blacksmith and wife Mary.12/1852 md 26 yrs 4children, 3 living. Old enough to have a son who married in 1884. I have no index for 1910 and for 1920, he could not be located in Missouri.

MEN IN THE MILITARY

Descendants of Reuben provided by Clarence Nuckols

Reuben Julian Nuckols served in the Confederate Army in the Civil War but was not killed in the war as has been reported in some of the data submitted by some one. The will of his mother, Eliza S. Nuckols, names him in her will written in 1881 as the inheritor of the largest portion of her estate. She also makes mention of him receiving his brother Andy's (Andrew) portion of the land because of Andy having been killed. Perhaps Andrew was killed in the Civil War and somehow it was mistakenly twisted to show Reuben as the one who was killed. Both of these brothers enlisted at the same date in 1861.

Reuben served in the Civil War in the 4th Regiment Calvary, Company G, of the Confederate Army. He was a courier for Gen. Robert E. Lee Nov. to Dec. 1862, transferred to McGregor's Battery, Stuart's Horse Artillery. He survived the Battle of Spotsylvania Courthouse although he was reported killed in action at that battle. Proof of his survival is that he appeared on two more census after the war was over. I think that it must have been his brother Andrew that was killed in that battle.

McGregor's Battery, 2nd Stuart's Light Horse Artillery was formed from members of the famous "Richmond Howitzers" in late 1862 under Captain Brown. Later, command was turned over to Capt. Brethard, and upon his promotion the battery became the responsibility of Capt. William McGregor of Alabama, remaining under his command for the duration of the war.

Stuart's Horse Artillery was organized by Col. John Pelham in order to provide the necessary fire power to turn JEB Stuart's cavalry into an effective offensive weapon. Elements of the battery serving under Capt. Brethard were instrumental in the defense of "The Cornfield" at Antietam.

By 1863 "McGregor's" Battery participated in action throughout Virginia, and was involved in the battle that saw the untimely death of John Pelham (The Gallant) at Kelley's Ford. The battery distinguished itself by leading an artillery charge against the Union right at Chancellorsville, and routing Union gunners from their position atop "The Hazel Grove."

McGregor's Battery followed JEB Stuart into Pennsylvania, arriving at Gettysburg late on the second day. The next morning they were posted at the center of the Confederate line during Stuart's flanking attack upon the Union rear at

the East Cavalry Field. The battery distinguished itself acting as Lee's rear guard by protecting the vital fords across the Potomac river as the Army of Northern Virginia retreated from Pennsylvania.

For the balance of the war, McGregor's Battery supported efforts to hold open the vital rail lines leading into the cities of Petersburg and Richmond. They fought at Five Points, Sailor's Creek and finally at Appomatox. Rather than surrender with the Army of Northern Virginia, legend has it that the members of McGregor's Battery buried their guns somewhere in southern Virginia or northern North Carolina as they attempted to link up with the ragged remnants of the Army of Tennessee under Gen. Joseph Johnston. Cutting their horses away from the traces, the members returned to their homes vowing to renew the fight when called upon. None of the members applied for, or received a parole until well after the cessation of hostilities

He was 75. Mr Nuckols was a chairman of the Agricultural Stabilization Board in Henrico County for some years and was president of the Henrico Mutual Fire Insurance Co. He is survived by a daughter, Mrs Chales R Davis, Jr of Richmond; two sons, A Page Nuckols of Beaverdam, a member of the Hanover County Supervisors, and Howard D Nuckols of Manakin-Sabot, a member of the Goochland County School Board; a sister, Mrs Guelda N Dabney and two brothers, Carlyle P Nuckols and Graham E Nuckols, all of Richmond. Funeral arrangements were incomplete Monday, but the family requests that in lieu of flowers, contributions be made to charity.
