Location—.8 mile east of Johnson's Station, Virginia on Route 622; thence north .8 mile leading to the house

(Buckingham Co, VA)

Date— About 1800

Owners— Joseph Nuckols 1800-1845

Charles Nuckols 1845-1891

Mrs Clara Nuckols Wren 1891-?

Description -

The original house is known to be very old but no definite information could be obtained since the records were destroyed by fire. The present owner is eighty-two years old and she says the date "1800" was inscribed on a rock near their back door when she was a child; her mother having told her it was thought to be the date that the house was built.

Only three rooms of the original

house is visible, as the home has been remodeled considerably. The foundation, chimneys and a part of the weatherboarding is the original. Four rooms were added and the original upstairs rooms were raised about 1923. From the small square front porch through large six panel doors, one enters into



a broad hallway. A lovely winding stairway leads to the second floor. To the right of the hall is a large living room and to the left is a very much smaller room used as a bedroom. These are the original rooms and very few changes have been made to them; nor to the basement. Modern mantels and windows

were put in these large rooms which are plastered with a three foot wainscoting. This home was built originally of heart pine, put together with wood pegs and shp (sic) made nails and spikes. The corner posts were hewn out of large trees. In remodeling, the house, it was very difficult to tear the old original rafters and other timbers down as they were so securely put together. Some were mortised in while others were put together with wooden pegs and large shop made nails or spikes. There are not any of the original outbuildings standing.

Israel Nuckols' Home

At Oscar Nuckols funeral a few weeks ago I learned from Norwood Nuckols that the future of the Israel Nuckols home in western Henrico County VA is not as secure as we had thought. The house has been sold to a developer who specializes in "infill" and who originally had planned to squeeze in a few townhouses on the property that surrounds the old house. That plan was opposed by neighbors, so the developer is expected to present a new or amended plan to the zoning board next week. According to Norwood, the old house has no legal protection for its historic value, though it is thought to be one of the oldest dwellings in the county. It is on only the County Registry, not the National Registry, and that carries no requirement for preservation. There is a possibility that the current owner might be moved to demolish it if he needs to make his expected return on the property. Norwood did note that the deed does contain an easement for family access to the graveyard, and there are both county and state laws regarding the preservation of burial sites. Even so, it would be a shame to lose the old house, which has been estimated to date to the 1790's. Given the current pace of development in the Richmond area and the level of property values, there may not be a lot anyone can do. If anyone out there has any ideas on how to get a river to run backwards, I would like to hear them. Thanks, Bill Davis

The homesite includes a family cemetery, exterior kitchen building, the home that Mr. Nuckols acquired in 1849, and a barn. We have been working with Mr. Norwood Nuckols to some degree, but if you have any information regarding this home that would be helpful to us or if you just want to let the county know that the area should be preserved, it would be greatly appreciated. We don't want to see the last bit of Nuckols family history in Henrico be destroyed.
